Gloucester City Hockey Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and be encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club.

As a member of Gloucester City Hockey Club you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect opponents.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit – *warm clothing, long socks, and shin pads* – for training and match sessions. If juniors do not bring shin pads they will not be permitted to take part in the activities. A mouth guard & a left hand padded glove are recommended.
- A cold drink – preferably non-carbonated- in a plastic container should be brought to all activities, glass containers are not allowed.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly. All junior members must pay a one off fee as required covering the period September to Easter. Cheques should be made payable to 'Gloucester City Hockey Club'. Match fees will generally cover the cost of pitch hire only.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
